Clear History: Internet Explorer

Steps to Take:

1-Close all Internet Explorer windows.

2-Open a new Internet Explorer session and click Safety > Delete Browsing History.

3-In the Delete Browsing History window, select Temporary Internet Files and Cookies. If you have saved any Pearson sites as Favorites, clear the Preserve Favorites website data check box.

4-Click the Delete button.

5-In the Delete Browsing History confirmation -window, click Yes, and then click Done after the files are deleted.

6-Click OK.

7-Close the browser and retry. If the problem persists, contact Technical Support for further assistance.

Clear History: Safari
